SUMMER TRANSITION WORKSHOP AUGUST 2023**Frequently Asked Questions (F.A.Q'S)**

Q When are the workshops running?

A The workshops will take place over two days (two sessions) during the Summer Holidays in August 2023.

Q Where will they be held?

A In the secondary school where your child will be attending in September.

Q Who will be running the workshops?

A The workshops are organised and funded by Powys County Council, a collaborative project with qualified professionals within Powys Children's services.

Q Who can attend?

A This opportunity is open to any year 6 pupil making the transition to High School in Powys this September.

Q What is the duration of the workshop?

A We anticipate the day will run from 10am. to 2pm.
Please make sure your child arrives ready to begin at 10am and is picked up promptly at the end.

Q Will snacks and drinks be provided?

A Participants are welcome to bring their own packed lunch, but healthy snacks and drinks will be provided on the day.

Q What should my child wear?

A We recommend comfortable casual clothing.

Q Do they need to bring any equipment extra i.e. stationery?

A No, all materials will be provided on the day.

Q What can I expect on the day?

A Fun and practical activities designed to support children moving up to Secondary school. They are held in the High Schools during the Summer holidays, when the school will be quiet, giving pupils the opportunity to explore the school grounds and familiarise themselves with the space before they start in September.

Q How do I apply?

A Teachers and parents can refer directly by following this link and completing the referral form. Please ensure that "Summer Transition" is stated on the form under "Referral Reason" and the name of the Secondary School that the child will be attending in September.

If your child requires any additional support or adjustments, please include this information on the referral, including any allergies, illnesses, disabilities or treatment/medication your child requires. For example; asthma (inhaler) disabled access, nut allergies (epi pen), etc.

For the purpose of reporting/promotion photographs may be taken on the day, if you do not wish your child to be photographed please state that in the referral.

Please ensure Parent contact details are included in the referral, as the primary schools will be closed, and we will not be able to access this information.

Please make your referral by 30th June 2023
